Foundation Student Ministries

History – While in the midst of a 12 month mentoring program with Dr. Johnny Hunt at First Baptist Church, Woodstock: Evangelist John Welborn began to pray about starting a specific kind of summer camp. He had been involved in many student camps, as a guest speaker, youth minister, student and chaperone throughout his life. However, he felt there was a desperate need for a camp fully focused on Worship & the Word. This camp should make Worship THE POINT and not an afterthought. This camp would be completely orchestrated in order to bring students and adults into a focused, intense and personal time of Worshiping their Creator. It would feature the best of the best in Biblical Preaching including pastors, educators, missionaries and authors.

In July of 2006, 117 people attended the first Foundation Camp in Black Mountain, North Carolina. During that first year, many lives were changed by the power of the Gospel. 31 people came to faith in Jesus Christ during that first “Worship and the Word” focused camp.

The summer of 2007 brought over 250 people in 2 separate camp weeks to Foundation Camp. These events were incredible and saw dozens come to faith in Jesus Christ. However, it was evident that Foundation Student Ministries was developing into more than just a Summer Camp.

Back in the year 2000, while John was attending Liberty University, pursuing his undergraduate degree, he met a passionate church planting family named Eddie and Jessica Cole. Eddie had left his growing church in Alabama and was seeking God concerning planting a church in the North-Eastern United States. The Lord led him to Staten Island, New York and Salem Church. Eddie was a guest speaker at Foundation Camp 2007 and had a crazy idea...that Foundation Student Ministries bring Christian teenagers from around the Southeastern United States to New York for an evangelistic mission project. This relationship helped birth “Foundation to the Streets,” a completely evangelistic mission project in New York City.

In 2008, Foundation Student Ministries hosted three major events. A beach camp on Hilton Head Island, South Carolina, a mountain camp in Chattanooga, Tennessee and a mission project to Staten Island, New York. These three events saw over 550 people involved and we saw, literally, hundreds of people come to Faith in Jesus Christ. If progression of the past is any indication of the future, then anyone involved in Foundation Student Ministries should “buckle-up!” It is going to be an incredible experience over the coming months and years.

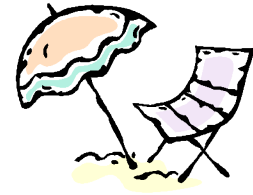
Ken’s Story - I just wanted to write you and tell you how things are going at our church in regards to my students. I have seen such a change in the hearts and lives of my students....The students are beginning to see their role in ministry. Jesus is working in their lives and giving them visions of works and rewards. They are more excited than I’ve seen them and my heart is overwhelmed as I watch them in their interaction with one another, their ministry to each other, our church and our community. For the first time, they are reaching out past the four walls of our student center and bringing in other students...not simply to participate in activities, but using that opportunity to tell them about Jesus. Zach has publicly surrendered to God’s call on his life in the area of student ministry and we are discussing putting him on staff part time with me for a while...while he prepares to enroll into TN. Temple....I do not believe that this is a “camp high”. I have been praying and I believe that God has done what He promised and is beginning a new work in all of our lives. I’ve got a student who was in such turmoil, so angry and bitter. He is addicted to pornography and seemed to be an outcast among all the students. To be honest, I have been dreading for 2 years even the thought of him coming into the youth group. But, this year at Foundation Camp ’07, he was radically saved. He has confessed his addiction to his peers and his parents. He is such a sweet young man and is beginning to participate in our student activities with all the other students. Praise God! I’ve got another student, 14 y/o, addicted to the same and into a few other things. He has also confessed to his parents and has asked them for help after being saved at Foundation Camp. Students are now meeting during the week (not on Wednesdays) and praying for each other and for the ones that aren’t committed or saved. Some are changing their MySpace sites to reflect their love for Christ and what they believe as Christians. There is still a long way to go, but I’m looking forward to seeing what God is going to do next. Who should attend this event? - We offer this event for Middle & High School students (6-12 graders)

How many chaperones should I bring? - We recommend 1 chaperone for every 5 students

What time do we start on day one? - Registration is from 3pm to 5pm on day one

What time are we finished on the final day? - The last session is finished by 11am on the final day

What does the price include? - All meals, lodging, t-shirt, booklet,
speakers, bands, counselors, rec. activities, pool, beach

Who should all checks be made out to? - Any and all checks are to be made out to John Welborn Ministries, Inc

Can I pay by credit card? - Yes, in order to pay by credit card, you must call our office

What are the sleeping arrangements like? - 1 BR Condos sleep 5 - two bunks, sofa bed, 1Queen (one bedroom)

Will there be a refrigerator in each room? - Each condo has a full kitchen

Will the condos belong to only our groups? - In order to accommodate each group, we cannot guarantee a full condo to your group. However, we will do our best to make sure no one is by themselves with another group

Can adults bring their younger children with them? - Yes, but they will still be required to pay the camp price.

Also, we cannot provide babysitting for younger children. Our focus must remain with the teenagers.

When is the deposit due? - Our camps are registered on a first come, first served basis. When they fill up, they are closed to any new groups. What time are we finished on the final day? - The last session is finished by 1pm on the final day

What does the price include? - All meals, lodging, booklet, counselors, mission projects

Who should all checks be made out to? - Any and all checks are to be made out to John Welborn Ministries, Inc

Can I pay by credit card? - Yes, in order to pay by credit card, you must call our office

What are the sleeping arrangements like? - 4 people in a hotel room (2 Queen Beds)

Will there be a refrigerator in each room? - Unfortunately, NO.

Will the hotel room belong to only our group? - In order to accommodate each group, we cannot guarantee a full hotel to your group. However, we will do our best to make sure no one is by themselves with another group

Can adults bring their younger children with them? - Yes, but they will still be required to pay the event price.

Also, we cannot provide babysitting for younger children. Our focus must remain with the teenagers and mission project
What will we be doing? - Reaching people for Christ. Your students will participate in street evangelism, block parties, basketball tournaments, community clean-up, servant-hood projects, spiritual surveys, outdoor concerts and events.

Will we need extra money? - We recommend bringing extra money for snacks, souvenirs, etc. We want to give you as much time as possible to enjoy the experience. Therefore, on your "Manhattan Day," lunch will be at your own expense.
